The last date for submission of application forms has been extended to 21st November, 2012. Cut off date for determining age shall remain to be determined as at 15th November, 2012 i.e. any candidate who will celebrate his/her 18th birthday on 15th November, 2012 will be eligible to apply.

Recruitments under the TRP scheme/policy will start from 26th November, 2012 simultaneously at 1st MLP Bn. Mawiong and at 2nd MLP Bn. Goeragre and will continue till end of Physical Efficiency Test (PET) are completed. The PET will be held inside the parade grounds of 1st MLP Bn., Mawiong and of 2nd MLP Bn., Goeragre respectively.

All candidates who have been given admit cards should report at the Recruitment Centres i.e. 1st MLP Bn, Mawiong and 2nd MLP Bn., Goeragre as per dates allotted in their admit cards and should report by 6:30 AM on the date of recruitment with original documents for scrutiny.

Any candidate who submitted false documents at the time of submission of application forms or is detected at any stage of the recruitment process will face penal action and his/her performance will be declared null and void.

The PET (Race) as advertised will involve a race of 10 (ten) Kms for male candidates and 5.5 (five Kms and half) Kms for female candidates. The approximate rounds for 10 Kms at 1st MLP Bn ground will be about 25 rounds and about 33 rounds in 2nd MLP Bn. ground. There will be medical team, emergency services at both the centres during PET and there will be query/complaint cells at the main gates, Physical Measurement Test (PMT) control room and at the Physical Efficiency Test (PET) control room in both the two recruitment centres.

The performance of the candidates both who qualified and disqualified at the Physical Measurement Test (PMT) as well as at the Physical Efficiency Test (PET) will be uploaded to the Meghalaya Police Website and the Notice Board on a daily basis.

Arrangements for written Tests will be circulated to the media only after the PET (Physical Efficiency Tests) are over.
