Due to the incessant rainfall and inclement weather in Meghalaya for the past few days there have been increase in water level and landslides in various parts of Meghalaya. In view of the same people are advised to take extra precaution during heavy rainfall as there is likelihood of flash flood, especially in areas near rivers and streams. They are not to go near the water or walk through moving water and stay away from streams, drains, culverts. People are advised not to drive through flooded areas and stay away from electric poles or power lines to avoid electrocution. Students are advised not to cross rivers and streams during heavy rain and tourists visiting tourist spots should not venture into streams, rivers and waterfalls.
